Processing of Personal Data Related to Participant Registration

This Privacy Notice is provided in English for the convenience of international participants. In the event of any discrepancy between the Hungarian and English versions, the Hungarian version shall prevail.

1. Data Controller

2. Purpose of this Privacy Notice

The purpose of this Privacy Notice is to inform participants of the **International Spatial Data Conference 2026** (hereinafter referred to as the **Conference**) about the processing of their personal data in accordance with Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council (General Data Protection Regulation – **GDPR**).

3. Processing of Personal Data

I. Registration for the Conference

Purpose of Processing

The personal data provided during registration are processed for the following purposes:

- receiving and managing registrations;
- maintaining the participant register;
- organising and administering the Conference;
- communicating with registered participants.

Categories of Personal Data Processed

The following personal data are processed:

- name;
- organisation;

- e-mail address;
- telephone number (optional).

Legal Basis

Article 6(1)(f) GDPR – processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the Data Controller.

The legitimate interests of the Data Controller include ensuring the efficient organisation and administration of the Conference, maintaining an accurate participant register and facilitating communication with participants.

Retention Period

Registration data will be retained for a maximum period of **two (2) years** following the conclusion of the Conference.

The retention period is justified by the administrative closure of the Conference and the preparation and organisation of subsequent events within the Conference series.

II. Communication with Participants

Purpose of Processing

Personal data are processed for the purpose of:

- providing participants with information relating to the Conference;
- communicating programme updates or organisational changes;
- responding to participants' enquiries.

Categories of Personal Data Processed

- name;
- e-mail address;
- telephone number (where provided).

Legal Basis

Article 6(1)(f) GDPR – legitimate interests.

Retention Period

Personal data processed for communication purposes will be retained for a maximum of **two (2) years** following the conclusion of the Conference.

III. Preparation of Name Badges

Purpose of Processing

To facilitate the identification of participants during the Conference and to promote professional networking among attendees.

Categories of Personal Data Processed

- name;
- organisation.

Legal Basis

Article 6(1)(f) GDPR – legitimate interests.

Retention Period

Personal data used for the preparation of name badges will be processed until the conclusion of the Conference.

Name badges will subsequently be securely destroyed.

IV. Photography and Video Recording

Purpose of Processing

Photographs, audio recordings and video recordings will be made during the Conference for the following purposes:

- documenting the Conference;
- presenting the professional activities of the Lechner Knowledge Centre;
- promoting professional knowledge sharing;
- preserving the professional content and outcomes of the Conference.

Categories of Personal Data Processed

The following personal data may be processed:

- image (photographs and video recordings);
- voice (audio and video recordings);
- any other personal data that may appear during the recordings.

The recordings primarily document the Conference as a whole and its professional programme.

Due to the nature of their participation, speakers may appear prominently in the recordings.

Participants asking questions or making comments during the Conference may also appear in the recordings and live broadcast.

Legal Basis

Article 6(1)(f) GDPR – processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the Data Controller.

The legitimate interests of the Data Controller include documenting the Conference, promoting professional knowledge sharing, preserving professional content and presenting its public-interest professional activities.

Retention Period

The recordings may be retained by the Data Controller for documentation and archival purposes.

V. Live Streaming and Publication of Conference Recordings

Purpose of Processing

The Conference will be streamed live via the internet and the recording may subsequently be made available on the official YouTube channel of the **Lechner Knowledge Centre**.

The purposes of this processing are:

- making the Conference accessible to a wider professional audience;
- supporting professional education and knowledge sharing;
- ensuring that the Conference presentations remain available for future viewing;
- preserving and disseminating professional knowledge related to the public-interest activities of the Lechner Knowledge Centre.

Categories of Personal Data Processed

- image;
- voice;
- any personal data appearing during the live broadcast or recording.

Legal Basis

Article 6(1)(f) GDPR – legitimate interests.

The legitimate interests pursued by the Data Controller include ensuring broad access to the Conference, supporting professional knowledge dissemination and documenting its public-interest professional activities.

Retention Period

The recording of the Conference may remain available on the official YouTube channel of the **Lechner Knowledge Centre** for future viewing, at the discretion of the Data Controller.

4. Recipients of Personal Data

Personal data collected during registration will not be disclosed to third parties.

The Conference will be streamed live and recordings may be published on the official YouTube channel of the **Lechner Knowledge Centre**.

Please note that YouTube (operated by Google LLC) acts as an independent data controller with regard to personal data processed through its platform. Information on YouTube's processing of personal data is available in YouTube's own Privacy Policy.

5. Data Processors

The registration platform and the related IT infrastructure are operated by the Data Controller.

Where necessary, the Data Controller may engage data processors in accordance with Article 28 GDPR. Any such processors shall process personal data solely on behalf of the Data Controller and in accordance with its documented instructions.

6. Mandatory and Optional Personal Data

Providing the following personal data is mandatory for registration:

- name;
- organisation;
- e-mail address.

Providing a telephone number is optional.

Failure to provide the mandatory personal data will prevent successful registration for the Conference.

7. Rights of Data Subjects

Under the GDPR, data subjects are entitled to the following rights:

- the right to obtain information regarding the processing of their personal data;
- the right of access;
- the right to rectification;
- the right to erasure ("right to be forgotten"), where applicable;
- the right to restriction of processing;
- the right to object to processing based on legitimate interests;
- the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority;
- the right to an effective judicial remedy.

Requests concerning the exercise of data subject rights may be submitted using the contact details provided in this Privacy Notice.

8. Right to Lodge a Complaint

If you believe that the processing of your personal data infringes the provisions of the GDPR, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority.
